- 1) For return flights, it is good to fly from the Senai Airport (15 min from UTM Johor by bus) although we could also cover airport transfer from KL International Airport (KLIA) or Singapore Changi Airport for a group of more than 10 students.
- 2) UTM Johor to KLIA will take about 3.5 hours by bus.
- 3) Complimentary Airport transfer services via Kuala Lumpur or Singapore are only provided for a group of students over 10 students and NOT individuals.
