## 1. Introduction



Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) is one of Malaysia's top five national universities. The university's main campus is in Johor Bahru, the southern tip of West Malaysia, covering an area of 1,177 hectares. There is also a city campus based in Kuala Lumpur City Central, covering an area of 38 hectares. UTM ranked 188<sup>th</sup> in the world, 37<sup>th</sup> in Asia in the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Ranking, and 9<sup>th</sup> in the Asia International Research Network. UTM has been rated as a QS five-star university for many years. The main campus is in the Johor Bahru campus in southern Johor, Malaysia, more than an hour's drive from the Singapore Airport; the Kuala Lumpur campus is only a 5-minute from the city centre of Kuala Lumpur.

There are 12 faculties covering chemical engineering and energy, electrical machinery, machinery, civil engineering, artificial intelligence, architectural environment and surveying, education, science, computer, management, art, and humanities. The faculties offer 171 programs, including undergraduate, master's and doctoral. The beautiful campus has convenient transportation support, including UTM and public buses. The campus is green, with birds' chips and flowers blossoming. The buildings are rich with Southeast Asian architecture. Comfortable on-campus student apartments provide students with a good living environment and excellent services. The campus has indoor and outdoor sports fields, and the gym and other facilities are well-equipped, with tennis halls, swimming pools, basketball halls, banks, restaurants, convenience stores and wireless networks. UTM currently has more than 24,000 students, including over 5000 international students. UTM is highly internationalized and has established cooperative relationships with many well-known universities in Europe, America, Asia, and Australia.

## **3. Application conditions**

- Open to full-time undergraduate and undergraduate students from colleges and universities cooperating with UTM.
- Independent and open to new environments.
- Physically and mentally healthy, abide by laws and regulations
- Recommended by the home international exchange office or academic advisor.
- Student group accompanied by at least one international officer/academic advisor for non-partner institutions.

## **4. Program Fee (MYR10,000 or USD2,300)**

- Study expenses include course fees, cultural and enterprise inspection fees, breakfast and lunches (Monday – Friday), and 1 farewell dinner.
- Accommodation fee (including sheets, quilts, pillows, pillowcases) Four students (of same gender) sharing a two-bedroom and one-living room apartment with air conditioning, two students sharing one room.
- Airport pick-up (Arrival: Johor only, Departure: Kuala Lumpur only) and transportation for all visits as stated.

**\*\*Note:** The fee does not include air tickets, insurance and personal expenses.

**Duration:** 4 weeks

**Fee:** Malaysian Ringgit MYR10,000 (approximately USD2,300)

**Accommodation:** 2 students share a twin or double room in an apartment for four students of the same gender.

**Meals:** Breakfast and lunches (Monday to Friday), and a farewell dinner. Each basic on-campus meal costs around USD 2-4.

**Transportation:** Transportation is provided during the project, but excluding during weekends and free time. Airport transfer service is provided as stated in the program. Taxi or Grab costs about USD3-5 to the nearby shopping areas outside the campus. Each taxi could take 4 passengers.

**Insurance:** Students must secure from home.

**International round trip airfare:** Excluded.
