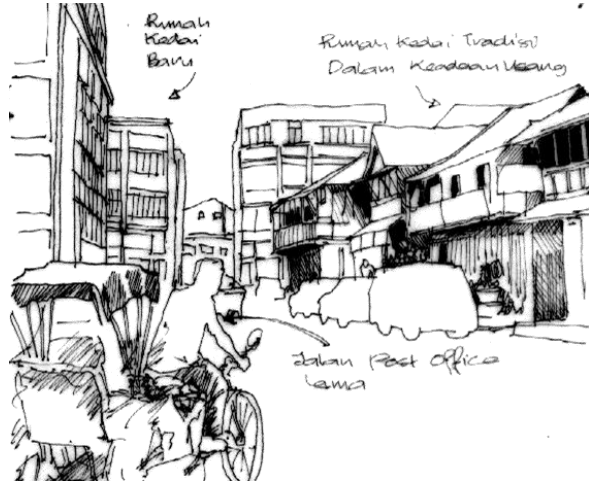
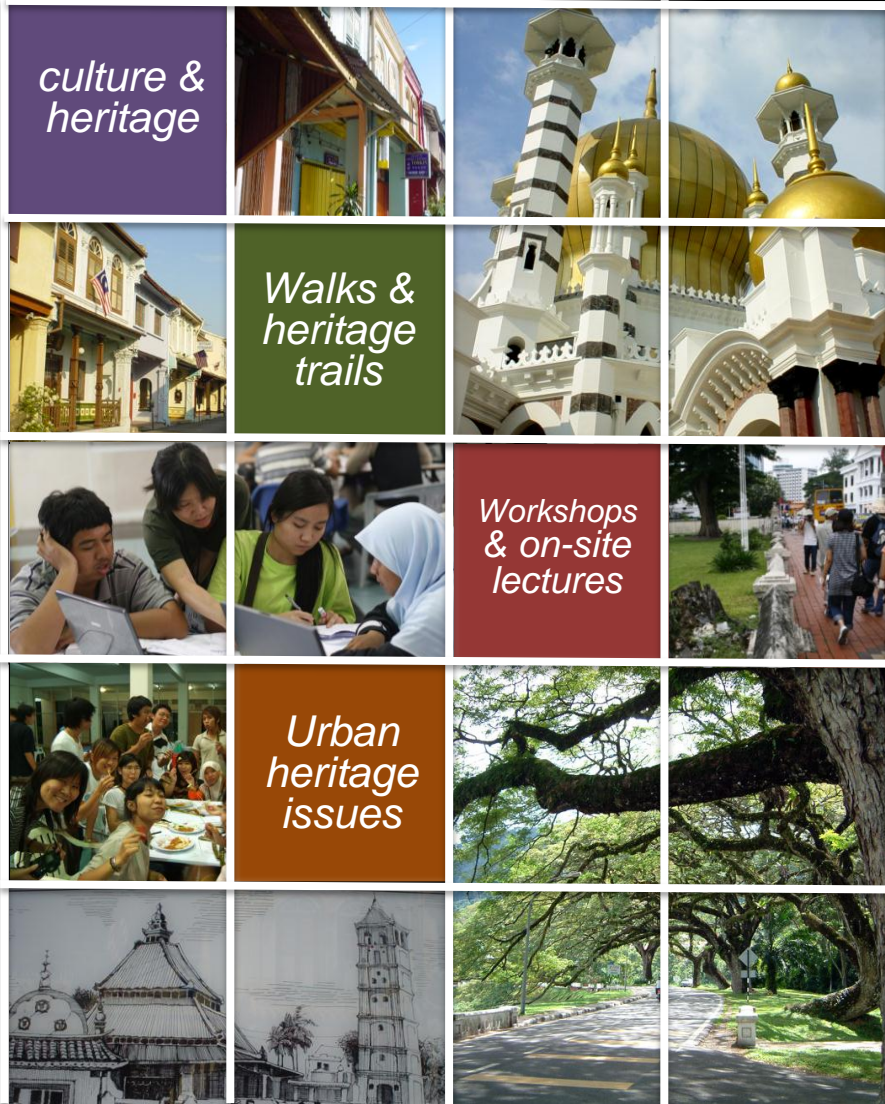

Heritage Walks and Town Trails are especially designed to train participants the “state of awareness” about the essential sensory experience and appreciating “places”. The field study program includes on site lectures and walking trails in heritage areas and towns in Malaysia and about appreciating the multi-contextual environment of Malaysian towns.



2 - 3 week Program

1st week:

Introduction to Malaysian Culture and Urban Heritage:

Include lectures and field visits to various places of cultural significance in Malaysia to sample the following topics:

- Local Foods and Customs
- Malaysian Urban History
- The Malay Traditional Towns
- The Colonial Towns
- The New Towns and Modern Influences

2nd Week and 3rd week:

Heritage Walks & Town Trails on the following places with workshops on urban heritage issues in some selected places:

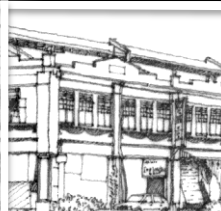
- Malaysian World Heritage Cities of Melaka and George Town

How the Program is Conducted

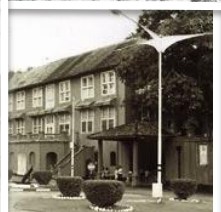
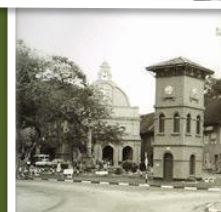
These programs involve classroom lectures, field visits and workshops and can be custom-made according to specific requests from the participants to fit their requirements.

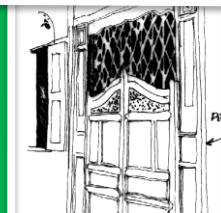
