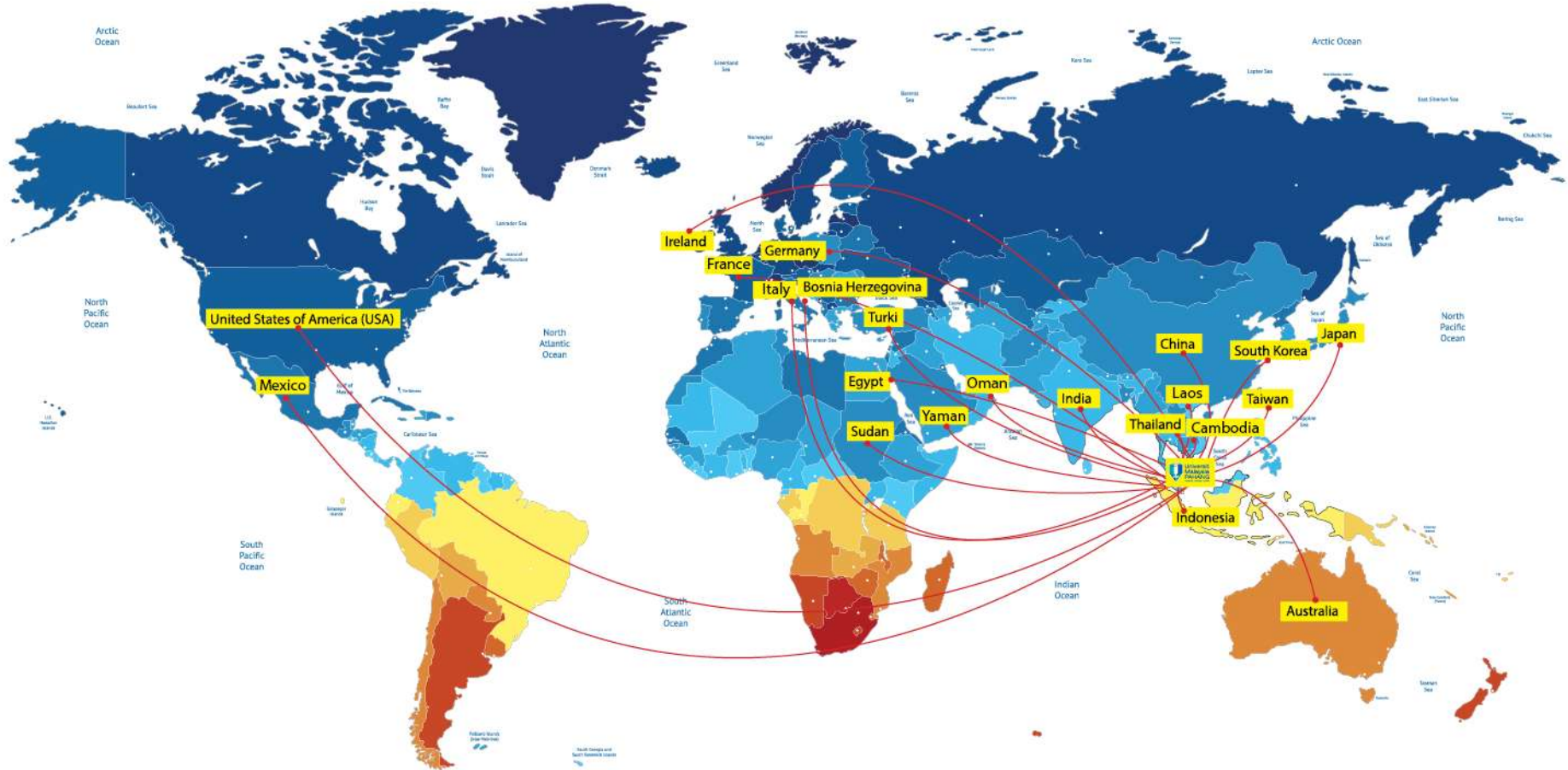
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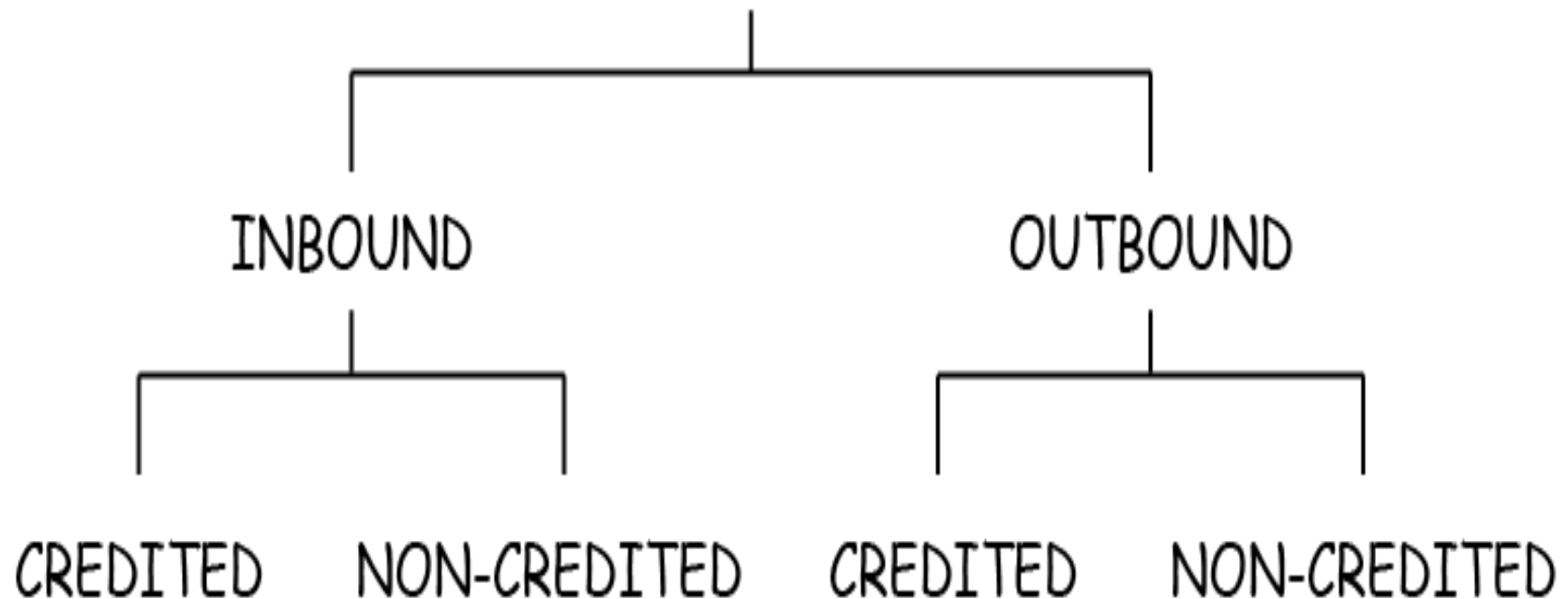

Credit-exchange programs

- both inbound and outbound

Non-credited programs

- Around D World Program (IO)
- academic visits (faculties)
- conference presentations (faculties/SAFFAD)
- community programs (SAFFAD/UMP/ faculties)
- research/data collection /use of lab equipment

3-PHASE PROGRAM

Phase 1 : PRE-MOBILITY

- engagement with faculties
- First Year Seminar

Phase 2 : DURING MOBILITY

- travelog
- personal reflections

Phase 3 : POST-MOBILITY

- Mobility for Employability Workshop
- Tracer Study

PHASE 1 ~ PRE-MOBILITY

Students work in groups of 8-10 students, to :

- Determine career goal
- Identify the relevant mobility program to help achieve the career goal
- Check the requirements of the program
- Plan for the program – location, duration, funding, team members (if necessary)
- Obtain necessary approvals
- Pre-departure preparations – travel documents (passport and visa), logistics and basic necessities (e.g. transportation, accommodation, food, clothing), the host culture, psychological issues

PROGRAM CHRONOLOGY

2009

- 82 students went abroad (USA, China, Indonesia, Hong Kong, Egypt, Australia)
- Academic Visit Programs initiated by DVC International & Academic e.g university / industrial visits

2010

- 181 students went abroad (Japan, Korea, Australia, Egypt, China, Indonesia, Thailand, Cambodia, India, Vietnam, Tibet)
- Upgraded to Overseas Assignment-Based Projects themed 'Footsteps Towards Humanity'

2011

- 3 students went abroad to Australia
- The implementation of the program has been revised, organized by 3 departments - BJIM, IO & JHEPA

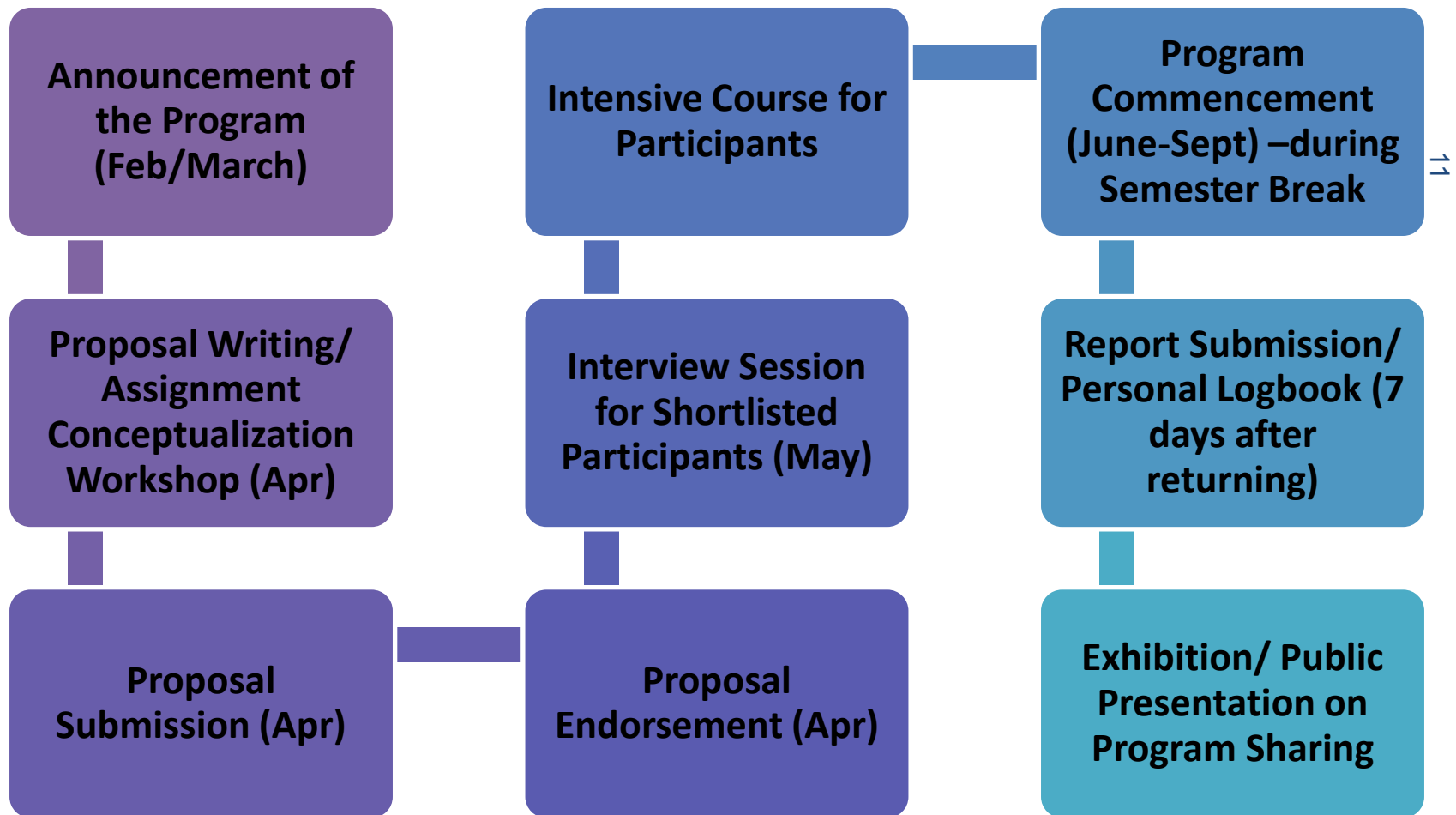
2012

- 51 students went abroad (China, Korea, Indonesia, India)
- The implementation of the program has been revised, organized by 3 departments - BJIM, IO & JHEPA

2013

- 57 students went abroad (Vietnam, Hong Kong & South Korea)
- The continuation of 2012 theme, more focus to ASEAN countries due to financial constraint.
