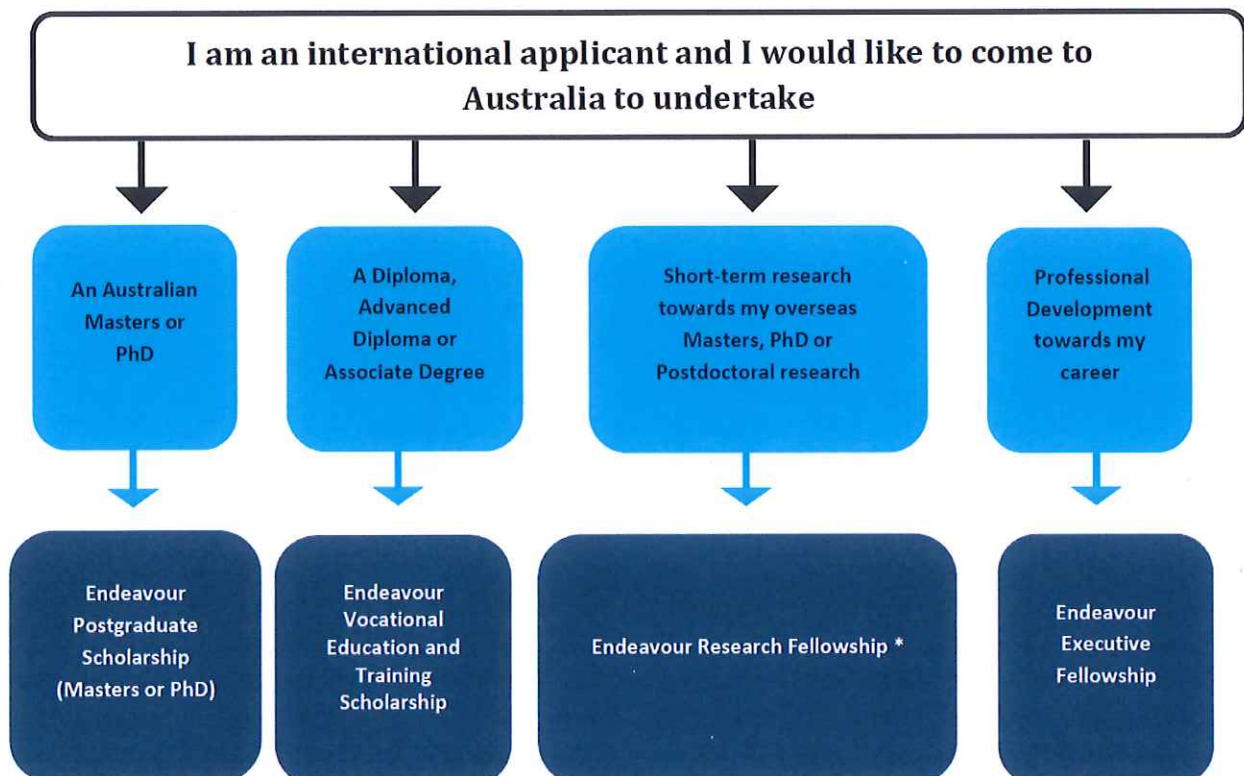
The Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships are internationally competitive merit based scholarships that provide opportunities for Australians and overseas citizens to undertake study, research and professional development around the world.

All recipients will receive*:

- travel allowance: \$3,000 (provision to pay up to \$4,500 under special circumstances)
- establishment allowance: \$2,000 (fellowships) or \$4,000 (scholarships)
- monthly stipend: \$3,000 (paid up to the maximum category duration on a pro-rata basis)
- health insurance for the full category duration (OSHC for international recipients)
- travel insurance (excluding during program for international recipients)

Endeavour scholarship recipients will also receive tuition fees paid up to the maximum study/research duration on a pro-rata basis. Tuition includes student service and amenities fees.

When can I apply for the 2019 Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships? Applications for the 2019 round are open around April and closes 30 June 2018. Please check the Endeavour Scholarship and Fellowships website for further information.

Where can I submit an application? Applications must be submitted using the Endeavour Online application system. Please refer to the website for further information.

How long will it take to have my application assessed? All applicants, both successful and unsuccessful are notified of the outcome of their application usually in the December of the round year.

Can the Endeavour Management team help me decide where I should undertake my study, research or professional development? Applicants for the Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships seeking a placement are required to make their own approaches to host organisations. I am an International applicant. Can I bring dependents with me while undertaking my Endeavour scholarship or fellowship? Family members or dependents wishing to accompany or visit an Endeavour scholarship or fellowship recipient in Australia should contact the Department of Immigration and Border Protection's nearest overseas mission for advice about travelling to and living in Australia. Before making the decision to bring your family it is important to consider the issues including: additional costs such as rent, food and other necessities; cost of health insurance; limited employment opportunities for your spouse; the effect on you and your study if your family is not happy in your host country; whether your children will adjust to school in your host country; waiting lists for child care centers. The department highly recommends that you arrange Health & Travel Insurance for all family members accompanying you. Scope Global and the Department of Education and Training will not, under any circumstances, be liable for any costs related to your family members' travelling with you during your scholarship or fellowship.
