

GUIDE FOR VISA APPROVAL LETTER (VAL) APPLICATION

STEP 1

Complete your documents

Scan and compile your documents listed in **Annex V** (ii) checklist accordingly.



STEP 2

Apply VISA & pay your student visa online

Apply and track application status at https://visa.gov.my




- 2. Track application status after 1 week of application
- 3. Immigration Malaysia will issue electronic Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) which can be downloaded at EMGS website after approval of VAL.
- 4. Print the eVAL to obtain Single-Entry-Visa (SEV) (refer step 3).

Noted: It may take 3-6 weeks for VAL approval.



STEP 3

Apply SEV at Malaysia Embassy



Countries without the Malaysia Representative Office need to obtain Visa on Arrival for Student (VOAS) at VOA counter located at Arrival Hall / Malaysia entry point upon arrival. Check countries granted VOAS at https://www.utm.my/international/visa-approval-letter-val/

NOTE: After approval of VAL and apply SEV, you may plan your travel. PLEASE PLAN TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS NEAR TO YOUR RECEPTION DATE (i.e. 1-2 days before reception date).

STEP 4 (POST-ARRIVAL)

Post-arrival Medical Check-up, Registration and Student Pass Endorsement Upon arrival at Malaysia (Immigration counter), show **your eVAL**, **SEV and Offer Letter** to the Immigration Officer. The Special Pass stamp will be endorsed by the Immigration for 30 days. Within the 30 days period of the Special Pass, you are required to complete the following step to obtain a Student Pass endorsement: -

- 1) Report to UTM International Office (Block S19 for UTM JB **or** 8th Floor, Menara Razak for UTM KL) for post-arrival medical check-up arrangement at UTM Health Center within 3 days of arrival.
- 2) Register as student as stated at offer letter (SRAD for UTM JB or School of Graduate Studies for UTM KL).
- 3) Submit document for **STUDENT PASS ENDORSEMENT within 7 days of arrival at UTM** International. Refer website https://www.utm.my/international/ for documents checklist.

NOTE: It should take **22 working days (or minimum 4 weeks)** upon receipt of a complete documents for student pass endorsement. The student pass application must get Supporting Letter from EMGS prior submit to Immigration Department. If student exit Malaysia (for any reason) without complete the student pass endorsement, your VAL and SEV will be **VOID.** You have to cancel previous VAL, apply new VAL and repeat the same process if you required to obtain for student pass in future.

- [Postgraduate only] Married students MUST enter Malaysia as a single traveler. Dependent passes can only be applied after a student's pass is issued. Visit https://www.utm.my/international/dependent-pass/ for details
- If VAL did not approve within specific time registration period, you are advised to postpone your study
 to the following semester. Kindly contact admission office at ugrad@utm.my or pgad@utm.my for
 details on registration.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- DO NOT PURCHASE YOUR FLIGHT TICKET until you have obtained the VAL & SEV approval.
- International Students WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to register with the University if you don't have VAL and SEV.
- Student is advised to travel to Malaysia WITHIN the period of the registration date (i.e. 1 or 2 days before reception date). The Special Pass is given for 30 days only.
- Students changing from another institution/university within Malaysia, please contact <u>visa@utm.my</u>
 / <u>isckl@utm.my</u> for variation/ progression procedures.
