- 2) UTM Johor to KLIA will take about 3.5 hours by bus. d
- 3) Complimentary Airport transfers service via KLIA are only provided for a group of students and NOT individuals.
- 4) Students can also join only the two weeks in Johor Bahru (excluding Kuala Lumpur and Malacca) upon special request; the fee will be USD1,200 for two weeks: 25 Feb- 11 March 2023.
